Halloween Beers? GET SPOOKY WITH THE TOP 5 HALLOWEEN-THEMED BEERS

- 1. Dogfish Head Pumpkin Ale, full-body flavored, including a blend of pumpkin flesh, spices, and brown sugar. 7% ABV, 28 IBU
- 2. Rogue Dead Guy Ale, it's packed with malty, fruity aromas with a spicy hop finish. 6.8% ABV, 40 IBU. A couple fun facts about this bad boy; the bottle glows in the dark AND the logo was originally created for All Soul's Day, which is just a few days after Halloween
- 3. New Holland Ichabod Pumpkin Ale, it's full of combined malted barley, pumpkin, cinnamon, and nutmeg flavoring to form a rather uniquely refreshing Autumn beer. 4.5% ABV, 26 IBU.
- 4. Lost Abbey Witch's Wit, it includes tons of citrus and spice blends! 4.8% ABV, 10 IBU.
- 5. Samuel Adams Octoberfest, It envelopes a toasted malty flavoring with hints of caramel hops. 5.3% ABV, 16 IBU.
